Oxford alumni supporting over 900 new students worldwide!


We were thrilled to receive such a positive response! Thanks to the commitment and collaboration of all involved, 937 new students participated in events across 26 countries.

Although the University of Cambridge paused its support this year, we are proud to share that 49 NOS events still took place — a testament to the strength and resilience of our global community. Attendance ranged from 2 to 97 participants!

Events by region


Introduction of data tracking

We already know from studies that engaging with students early on, can foster long-lasting connections and benefits. To quantify this knowledge, this year we asked groups to collect student attendee names. The information will form the basis of a data tracking process, so that over time we are able to assess the impact of alumni support on individual student outcomes.

Feedback from groups

All groups received a follow-up email from the Networks Team with a focus on the following three questions. Feedback was received from 30 groups.

- Do you collect/record your own student contact data? We are encouraged to learn that the majority of groups (68%) collect student names for their own use. Hosting a NOS event provides an opportunity for groups to engage with future alumni at an early stage.
- If yes, for what purpose? Over half (57%) of the groups who sent a response add the students to their mailing list. Of these, 20% invite students back for drinks in December or to next year's NOS event.



Is any other support needed from the Networks Team to help organise a Freshers' event? The majority of groups are happy with the support provided. Some groups requested more general support and all comments will be responded to on an individual basis.

Best practice to share

- If you struggle to find a venue to host your NOS event, ask your members if they have access to a corporate office or school venue that could be used.
- Consider a reduced rate or student membership category for your group.
- Encourage the students to create a WhatsApp group, so they can stay in touch with eachother when in Oxford.
- Request student feedback to make your event even better.
